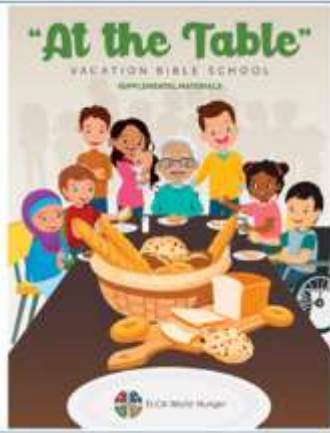
JOIN IN THE FUN AT TRINITY
